




Norte Region: the main Portuguese NUTS II in terms of population and economic activity...








Energy efficiency and social housing in Norte: regional specificities

84% Entirely owned by municipalities




Specific climatic conditions in EU context



Integrating energyefficiency in wider social and environmental policies




Key messages
