Background

Digital Europe aims to accelerate and lead to digital transformation in Europe. It represents a strategy to develop EU's digital capacities and to facilitate the deployment of digital technologies for the broader use of European citizens, public administration and companies.

Digital Europe seeks to reinforce the investments in the following technological areas:

- Supercomputing
- Artificial intelligence (AI)
- Cybersecurity
- Advanced Digital skills
- Ensure an extended use of these technologies in the economy and society matching the ambitious objectives and sustainability values in Europe.

The budget proposal for Digital Europe amounts to 8,2 B€ for the whole period 2021-2027. Implementation is ensured by the European Commission, through General Directorate of Communication Networks, Content and Technology (DG CONNECT). Apart from this programme, the digitalisation of the economy and services will be cross-cutting issues for the next period in all EU programmes.
