


EU4Health work programmes – 4 strands of action + cancer

Joint Actions

Requires participation from ministries, government departments or their nominees

Public Procurement

Contracts with economic operators to purchase services on the account of the Commission. The calls for tenders are published on Ted.



Action Grants

- Applicants must submit a project proposal (most of the calls require a consortium with at least 3 different MS)
- Academia, education establishments, research institutes, national and regional health authorities, hospitals, civil society organizations (associations, foundations, NGOs and similar entities) are potential applicants


